Steve Simmons—Westbury Class of 1975

Simmons is the deputy executive director of the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT), where he implements and manages TxDOT policies and program and assists with the daily administrative and engineering operations of the department. Simmons became the deputy executive director Nov. 1, 2001. He earned his bachelor's degree in civil engineering from the University of Houston in 1981 and is a licensed professional engineer. Simmons held numerous management positions in TxDOT's Houston District and was the District Engineer for the Fort Worth District.

Heather Hays—Westbury Class of 1984

Hays is an Emmy-Award-winning news anchor who has worked in television news for close to 20 years. Her first job, "Watch Heather with the weather," was a little different then what she is doing now. She was also a general assignment reporter, shooting and editing her own stories. She's come a long way since then. Today Hays is in one of the top five markets in the country—Dallas/Ft. Worth—as an evening news anchor for Fox News. But she still gets out from behind the anchor desk to work on special reports/shows including "Countdown to Kick Off" (co-hosting the Dallas Cowboys first home game pregame show live from the field) and other live specials.

Charles R. Nolen—WHS Band Director, 1973–85

Nolen attended the University of Alabama, joined the Army and play in the Army band for 2 years. After being discharged, he went on the road, working mainly out of Chicago, and played in 39 states with several well-known dance bands. Nolen went back to college and finished his degree at the University of North Texas and began teaching band in Dallas and Alabama. He moved to Houston in 1971 and taught at Sam Houston State University for 2 years before transferring to Westbury in 1973. While at Westbury, Nolen built a terrific music program, and he was awarded the Outstanding Band Director for 1973 by the National Association of Jazz Educators. Nolen retired from teaching in 1985.

Cindy Chapman—Westbury Community Leader

Chapman has served on the Westbury Civic Club (WCC) Board for 8+ years, serving as WCC president from 2008–2010, and is currently director of community relations. She has been involved in the community since the early 1990's, working to improve Westbury and Hager Parks, as well as with the Anderson SPARK project. The WCC is one of the largest subdivisions—over 5,000 homes—in Houston and has received numerous awards while Chapman was president. She continues to be an advocate for Westbury and active with other community organizations.
